General Information

The **Best Western Hotel Turismo** is located in **San Martino Buon Albergo**, in the province of Verona, in Via Nazionale 58.

The hotel staff has been trained and is aware of the characteristics of people with autism spectrum disorders, of their special needs, and knows how to make the hotel fully inclusive.

Check-In and Check-Out

The lobby of the Best Western Hotel Turismo has sofas, armchairs, chairs and desks for waiting. To access the lobby there are 2 automatic sliding doors. The lobby measures about 140sq m and at peak times crowding and increased waiting times could induce sensory overload.

During the day the most crowded times are:


- between 7am and 9.30am
- between 6pm and 8pm

In the weekends and in July and August:

- between 10am and 12pm
- between 2pm and 6.30pm

It is therefore advisable to check-in and check-out outside these hours.

The hotel is always open and has a big free parking and an unguarded covered garage.

Room

The rooms dedicated to clients with ASD are equipped with features that can help in the case of atypical sensory reactivity:

- there are no neon lights but soft lighting
- the room is located far from noise sources
- · cleaning products are fragrance free
- air fresheners are not used

The bedding is white and a duvet is available to quests.

For specific needs, guests are allowed to bring with them their own **personal items** (**blankets** or **cushions**) and the staff will make the bed. The window can be opened completely, and the room can be totally blacked out. In the bathroom there is a shower.

In the room there is minibar with snacks and canned drinks, glass water bottles, eco-friendly plastic cups.

On the desk there is kettle with disposable paper cups, service guide, an alarm clock radio with a red light (easily dimmable).

On the bedside table there are a notepad and a pen.

Breakfast room

The breakfast room is located on the ground floor, next to the bar area.

A table will be reserved for you in an area of the restaurant free from anything that could induce sensory processing disorder, away from busy passageways.

The breakfast room is open from 7am to 10am.

The times of increased client influx, that may lead to a higher risk of sensory overload are:

• from 8am to 9.30am

Background music is played at a low volume.

There is a 54" TV, switched on a muted news channel, no remote control.

Guests can bring their own food and drink at the table.

If you communicate any **special needs** in advance, the hotel kitchen will do their best to satisfy your requests.

You will also find in your room, the breakfast menu with augmentative and alternative communication symbols.

During the summer season, breakfast can be served in the covered outside area, close to the garden.





Hotel Information

The Best Western Hotel Turismo is located only 100 mt from a bus stop. You can reach Verona city centre (9 km) in about 20/30 minutes. The Verona railway station (about 13 km) can be reached in approximately 25/35 minutes. Tickets can be bought on the bus and the cost is around 2.50-3.00€ per person, one way.

The centre of Verona offers several internationally renowned cultural and artistic attractions: the Arena, the Roman theatre, Juliet's tomb and house, the Colombare Park, Castelvecchio, many museums and the Arsenale playground.

4 adult bikes are available for free.

There is a big parking place outside the hotel and a free covered garage.

Close to a supermarket (100 mt - open every day from 9am to 8pm), a Restaurant-Pizzeria (200 mt - open every day from 7am to midnight), a Health & Beauty store (50 mt - open every day from 9am to 7pm), the "Le Corti Venete" shopping centre (1.5 km - open every day from 10am to 8pm).
